

T -ball Game Guidelines

Parkville Baseball

- 1) Each game will consist of 3 innings time permitting. Every child plays the entire game.
- 2) Fielding will consist of a player on the pitcher's mound, four other infielders (1st, 2nd, 3rd, shortstop) and five outfielders.
- 3) When batting in the 1st and 2nd inning runners will advance one base on any batted fair ball. Ex. Batter goes to 1st base and stops. Anyone on base proceeds to next base and stops.
- 4) When batting in the 3rd (last inning) all players circle all bases for a home run.
- 5) Each player bats until they hit a ball in fair play. Each player bats every inning.
- 6) There are no recorded outs.
- 7) We as coaches should still teach the players how to record an out. They will need to do this at the next level.
- 8) During the game switch player's positions in the field. By the end of the year we should be able to tell a player to go to any position on the field and they will go, knowing where it is.
