

# T -ball Game Guidelines

## Parkville Baseball

- 1) Each game will consist of 3 innings time permitting. Every child plays the entire game.
- 2) Fielding will consist of a player on the pitcher's mound, four other infielders (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, shortstop) and five outfielders.
- 3) When batting in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> inning runners will advance one base on any batted fair ball. Ex. Batter goes to 1<sup>st</sup> base and stops. Anyone on base proceeds to next base and stops.
- 4) When batting in the 3<sup>rd</sup> (last inning) all players circle all bases for a home run.
- 5) Each player bats until they hit a ball in fair play. Each player bats every inning.
- 6) There are no recorded outs.
- 7) We as coaches should still teach the players how to record an out. They will need to do this at the next level.
- 8) During the game switch player's positions in the field. By the end of the year we should be able to tell a player to go to any position on the field and they will go, knowing where it is.
